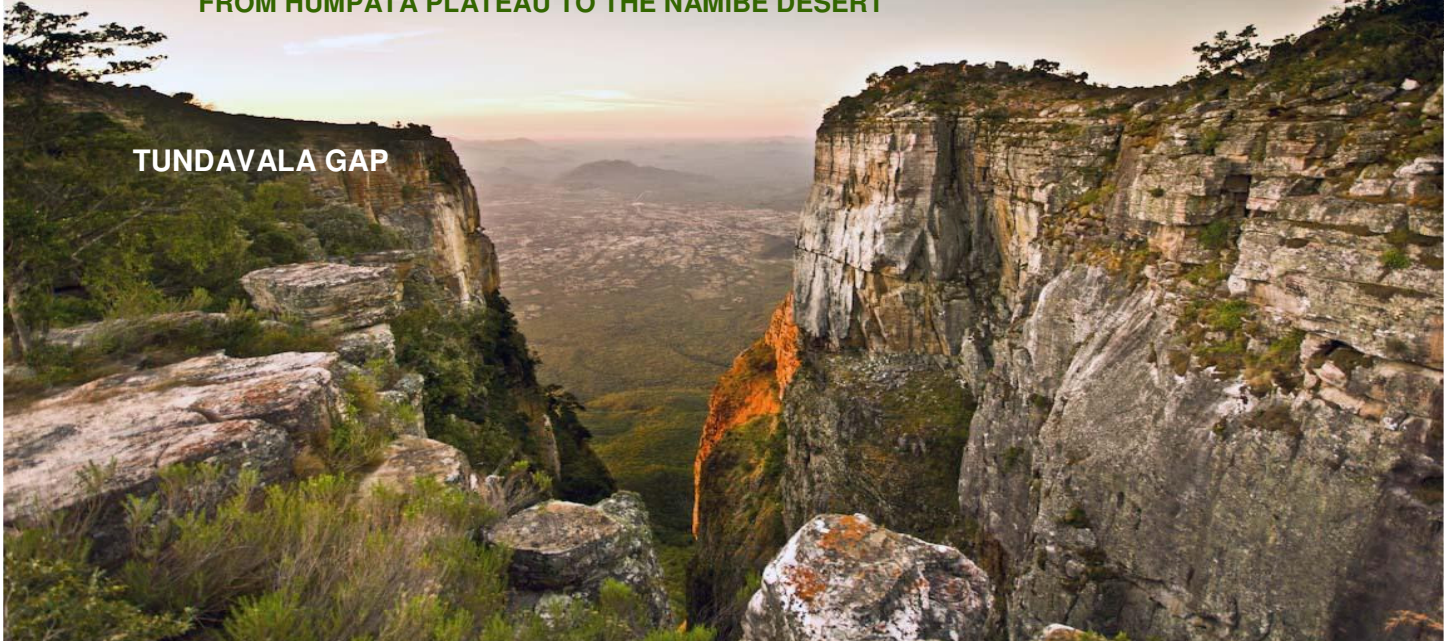

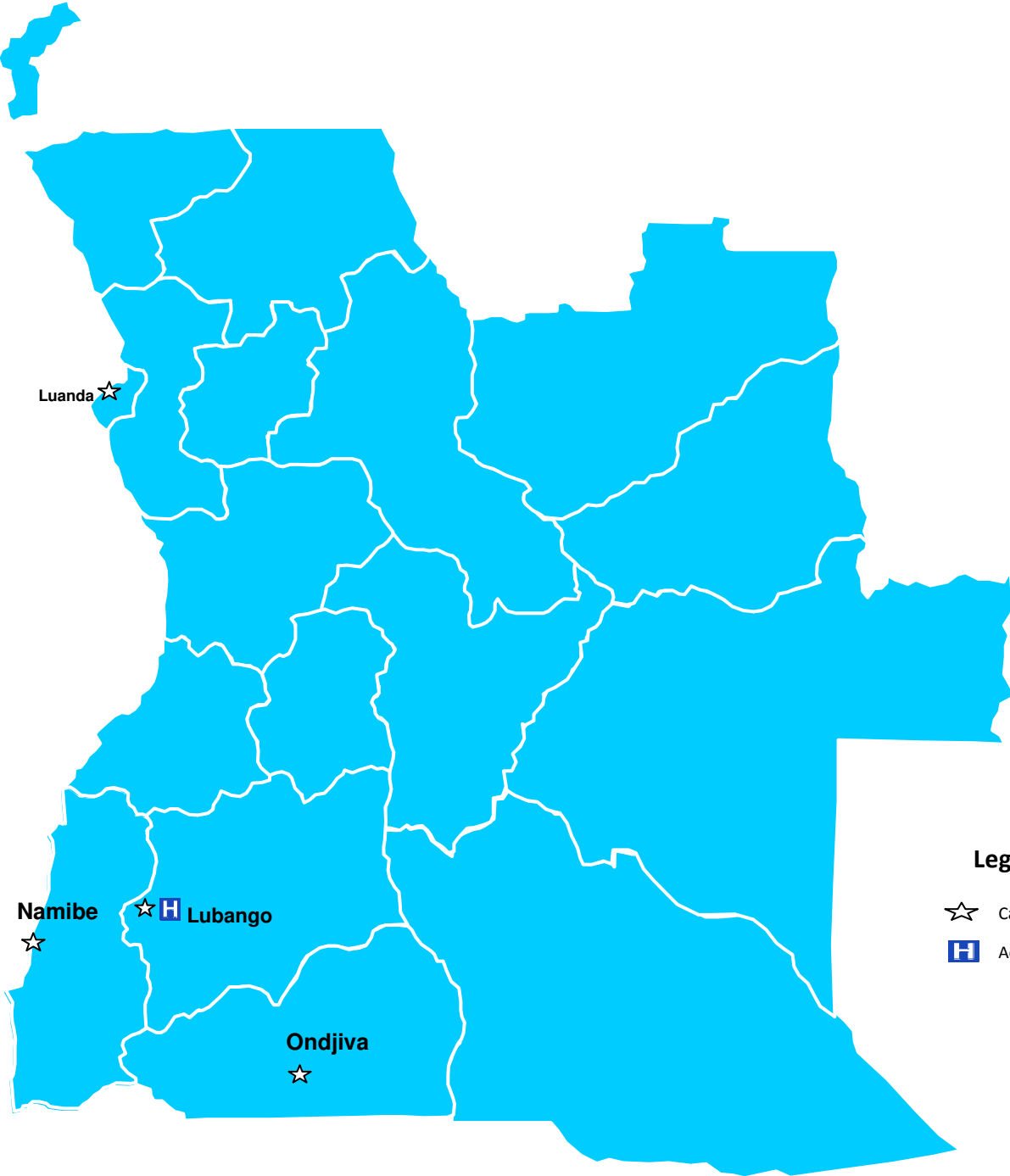

FIELD TRIP IN ANGOLA

Southern Angola: *After the Congress, a six-day field trip will be organised through three provinces of southwestern Angola (Huíla, Namibe and Cunene), starting and ending in the city of Lubango, with the purpose to observe some main sites of geological interest in this zone of Angola.*

Title: From the Humpata Plateau to the Namib Desert (Angola)

Leader: Isabel Maria Ratola Duarte (University of Évora - UE, Portugal)

Associated leader: Antonio Olímpio Gonçalves (University of Agostinho Neto - UAN, Angola)

Abstract: This field trip allows the participants to visit the Tundavala Gap, a huge escarpment of more than 1,000 m high cutted in Neo-Archean and Paleo-Proterozoic igneous rocks, and the Katchillwa Waterfall, on a quartzitic scarp at 2,200 m.a.s.l.. On the second day, the destination is the carbonatites complexes of Tchivira and Bonga, belonging to the Mesozoic alkaline massifs of ultrabasic rocks, a rift valley system produced during the Early Cretaceous. On the third day, the visit will involve the Lubango-Cunene Anorthosite Complex, which constitutes one of the biggest masses of anorthosite of the world. This region of Cunene is privileged to appreciate a kind of Eco-construction, made of raw earth, built with ancient techniques, which constitute a real GeoHeritage. On the fourth day the destination of the field trip is the iron mines of Cassinga, one of the five main iron mining zones of Angola. In the fifth day, the itinerary is through Leba passage, a spectacular part of the *Serra da Chela*, towards the volcanic basic rocks of Namibe and also to an interesting paleontological site, in the area of Bentiaba. In the sixth day, the field trip will continue to the Namib Desert (UNESCO World Heritage Site), the only place in the world where the exotic plant *Welwitschia mirabilis* can be observed, finishing at the beautiful bay of *Tombwa (Porto Alexandre)*, where can be observed heavy metals in their beach sands.

General information: Arrival at Lubango Airport and transfer to hotel at 4th September/2016; Duration - 6 day excursions: Departing from Lubango at 5th September/2016, arriving to Lubango at 10th September/2016 and overnight stay in Lubango; travel by 4x4 all-terrain vehicles; 11th September/2016, free day in Lubango and/or departures. Every nights at the hotel in Lubango.
